2018 Award: \$2,500.00 each to three eligible applicants. Selection of the Rotary Club of Warwick Scholarship Committee is final.

Eligibility: High School Senior attending a Warwick High School who has demonstrated a strong commitment to service within the community and to the principles of Rotary – Service Above Self.

Acceptance at any post-secondary educational institution accredited by the National Association of Schools and Colleges or the Department of education in the state where the institution is located.

A completed application package* must be received prior to the deadline for the current year to be eligible for consideration.

Package Requirements:

1. Completed Application: available on www.WarwickRotaryRI.com/scholarships
2. Proof of community service
3. Letter of recommendation from a local service organization or community leader
4. High School transcript
5. A confidential Statement of Financial Need from the parent(s)/legal guardian. Statement should include:
 - Current financial status:
 - parent/legal guardian net income
 - number of people living in the household
 - number of minors who will be attending an institution of higher learning during the same time frame as the applicant
 - types of public assistance receiving
 - other avenues where you are seeking financial assistance
 - Anything else we have not asked that you think would be pertinent in the decision making.
