**A completed application package\* must be received prior to the deadline for the current year to be eligible for consideration.**

- Applications accepted November 1 through January 31. Applications postmarked after January 31 will not be eligible.
- Awards will be announced in March. Grant Recipients will receive their check at a Rotary Club of Warwick meeting in April.

Requirements:

- Completed Application
- A copy of the organization's 501 (c)(3) letter
- A maximum 2-page narrative summary [12 pt font] and timeline of the project/program you are requesting funding for, include how intended outcomes will be measured (may be attached)
- One additional attachment: brochure, photo collage, document to demonstrate the benefit of the project/program (optional)
- If funding request exceeds \$3,000 the [Budget Form](#) must also be completed
- Grant Recipients must attend a Rotary Club of Warwick meeting within 6 months of receiving the check and provide a short presentation on the project funded and outcomes achieved
- Verification of expenses may be requested

*Grant recipients are encouraged to acknowledge the Rotary Club of Warwick in their publicity.*
